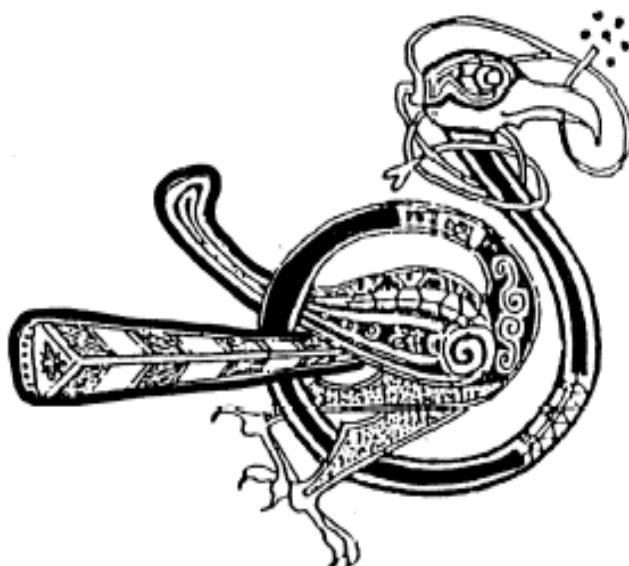

RULES

- 1 Where there is an age limit for any competition, a competitor's age will be taken as that which he/she had reached on or before 1st January 2009
- 2 The decision of the adjudicator is final as to quality. An objection on any other grounds maybe lodged by a teacher in writing on payment of a fee of £7.00
- 3 There must be perfect silence in the hall during the performance of each competition
- 4 Dancers must be in full costume including shoes for the presentation of prizes
- 5 **Children up to and including the age of 12 are prohibited from wearing face make-up.**
- 6 **All dancers are prohibited from wearing any form of glitter on their face.**
- 7 There is to be no changing of costumes in a competition hall. Changing rooms are provided
- 8 **NO SMOKING or Alcohol permitted anywhere within the school grounds**
- 9 Mobile phones must be switched off or on silent in competition halls
- 10 Any form of unauthorised photography which captures a dancer's image whilst taking part in competition is expressly forbidden. This covers photography by means of cameras, mobile phones, video camera and cine recorder, with or without flash facility. However they may be used during prize giving.
- 11 Competitors in Beginners A, B and figure must wear class costumes or skirt and blouse etc. Those wearing solo costumes will not be allowed to compete and their entry fee will not be refunded
- 12 Beginners A – Confined to competitors who have never won 1st place in that particular dance in any age group
- 13 Beginners B – Confined to competitors who have never won 1st place in that particular dance in any age group
- 14 Pre-Open – Confined to competitors who have never won 1st place in that particular age group. Age the competition to be under is specified. Competitors may only compete in the group above if a dance is not catered for on the syllabus
- 15 Open – Open to all competitors. Competitors may not dance out of their age group
- 16 In the case of ceili and figure competitions where it is specified over a particular age it is permissible to have 25% of a team younger than the age specified.
- 17 Dancers must compete in at least one open solo competition to be eligible to compete in Open Solo championships
- 18 Once a dancer has won 1st prize in a competition they are not eligible for forthcoming competitions even if they have been pre-paid
- 19 Confined Trophies – are confined to dancers whose teachers are registered with the London, London & Home Counties and Southern England Region branches
- 20 Outside London Trophies – Confined to dancers outside of the London, London & Home Counties and Southern England Region Branches

NO SMOKING WITHIN SCHOOL GROUNDS PLEASE,
YOU MUST GO OUTSIDE OF THE SCHOOL GATES

Under Health and Safety, competitors are requested not to smoke whilst dressed in their dancing costume.

AIRPORTS

HEATHROW – is the closest airport, being some 30 mins from Woking

GATWICK - Is approx 40mins from Woking

LUTON/STANSTEAD – these airports would take approx 1.5 – 2 hrs from Woking

ACCOMMODATION

Holiday Inn – Woking £69.00

This is the closest Hotel we have been offered an excellent rate of £69 per room per night including breakfast. Apart from standard rooms, there are family rooms with twin double beds therefore accommodating 4 persons. (2 adults & 2 children) However the hotel has a standard policy, which states children may not share beds with anyone other than family, and not to be more than 2 adults per room, for fire and safety reasons.

It would take approx 8-10mins by taxi from hotel to feis venue.

This venue is 5mins walk from Woking town and the Peacocks Shopping centre, cinema and New Victoria Theatre and ten min walk to the station.
