Feis Rules

1. This Feis is run under the rules of An Comhdháil Múinteoiri na Rinci Gaelacha.
2. Solo costumes may not be worn in any competition up to and including Under 9. Class costumes or skirt and blouse/top must be worn in all beginner competitions.
3. Facial make-up may not be worn in any competition up to and including Under 12.
4. Age as determined on January 1st 2018.
5. No changing of costumes will be permitted in the hall.
6. Dancers should be properly attired at all times.
7. The use of photography during competitions is expressly forbidden. This includes photography by mobile phone, video camera or Cine camera. Photographs may be taken during the presentation of prizes.
8. Competitions may be added or withdrawn, depending on time.
9. The adjudicators' decision in all circumstances will be final.
10. **Litter must be placed in bins provided.**
11. The committee accepts no responsibility for any personal injury or loss of property during the Feis.

Please note:

- **Under 5- Under 8:** Dancers can dance **BOTH** Light Jig **AND** Heavy Jig
- **Under 9- Under 14:** Dancers may dance Light Jig **OR** Heavy Jig.
- Dancers wishing to take part in the Open Championship (Under 9- Over 18 age-groups) must compete in both the open heavy jig and open reel.
- **DANCERS MAY ONLY COMPETE IN ONE GRADE PER DANCE (with the exception of dancers wishing to compete in the open championship who may need to double up for the heavy jig and reel (see note above)).**
- All confined and open championships will be adjudicated by **1 adjudicator**.
- **Team Competitions:** Dancers who have competed in the U8 Figure Dance may not compete in the U11 2 Hand Reel. Dancers may only compete in one two hand reel competition.

Grading system:

- **Beginner Grades:** Competitors must dance basic steps in all beginner dances. Class costumes or skirt and blouse/top must be worn in all beginner competitions.
- **Pre-open Grade:** Open to dancers who have never won a 1st place in a pre-open or open competition in that particular dance.
- **Open Grade:** Open to all dancers.
- **Confined Reel-** Confined to those dancers who have not yet won a 3 adjudicator championship.
