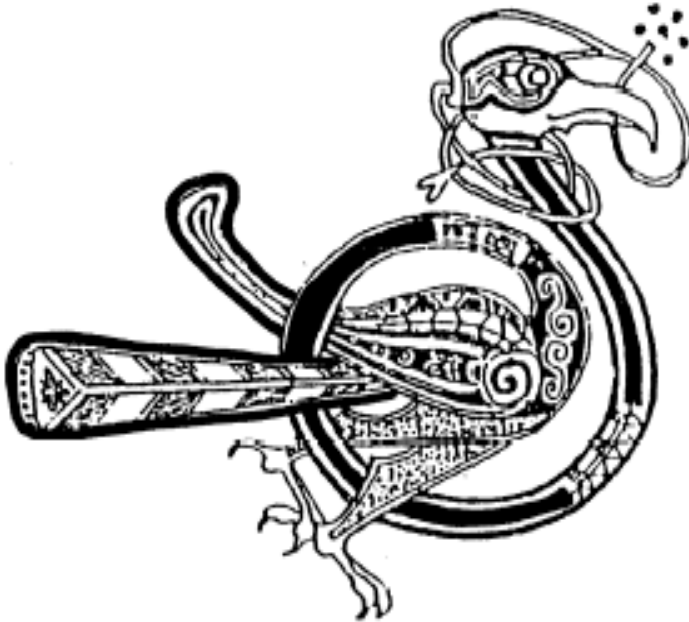

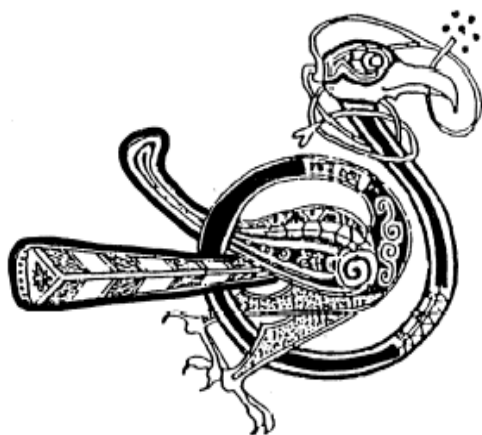

# RULES

1. Where there is an age limit for any competition, a competitor's age will be taken as that which he/she had reached on or before 1st January 2018
2. The decision of the adjudicator is final as to quality. An objection on any other grounds maybe lodged by a teacher in writing on payment of a fee of £15.00
3. There must be perfect silence in the hall during the performance of each competition
4. Dancers must be in FULL costume including shoes for the presentation of prizes.
5. Children up to and including the age of 12 are prohibited from wearing face make-up.
6. All dancers are prohibited from wearing any form of glitter on their face.
7. There is to be no changing of costumes in a competition hall. Changing rooms are provided
8. **NO SMOKING** or Alcohol permitted anywhere within the school grounds, this includes Electronic and Vaporisers, as per School rules.
9. Mobile phones must be switched off or on silent in competition halls
10. Any form of unauthorised photography which captures a dancer's image whilst taking part in competition is expressly forbidden. This covers photography by means of cameras, mobile phones, tablets, video camera and cine recorder or portable electronic devices, with or without flash facility. Photos may be taken during prize giving.
11. Competitors in Beginners A, B and figure must wear class costumes or skirt and blouse etc. Those wearing solo costumes will not be allowed to compete and their entry fee will not be refunded
12. **Beginners A** – Confined to competitors who have never won 1st place in that particular dance in any age group
13. **Beginners B** – Confined to competitors who have never won 1st place in that particular dance in any age group
14. **Pre-Open** – Confined to competitors who have never won 1st place in that particular age group.
15. **Open** – Open to all competitors. Competitors may not dance out of their age group
16. Competitors may only compete in the age group above, if a dance is not catered for in their own age group.
17. In the case of Ceili and figure competitions where it is specified over a particular age it is permissible to have 25% of a team younger than the age specified.
18. All Competitors must wear their number card positioned centre front, clearly displayed for adjudicators.
19. From U9 upwards dancers must compete in at least one open solo competition to be eligible to compete in Open Solo championships.
20. Once a dancer has won 1st prize in a competition they are not eligible for forthcoming competitions even if they have been pre-paid
21. **Outside London Trophies** – Dancers whose teachers are registered outside of the London & Home Counties and Southern England Region Branches
22. **Beginner A Trophy** – Competitors must be in Beginners A for the Reel. Winner will progress a grade for this dance.
23. **Margaret Gunn Beginners Memorial Cup** – Competitors must be in Beginners A or B for the dance they perform in the cup dance. The Winner will progress a grade for the dance performed. These Cups are Perpetual and MUST be returned the following year.
24. **Pre Open Trophy's** – Dancers must have danced in one of the pre Open competitions in their own age group this does NOT include the Treble Reel. Dancers must be in Pre Open for the dance they perform in the trophy dance. Winner will progress a grade for the dance performed.
25. **Londubh Cups \*\*\*** – Are confined to dancers within the London & Home Counties and Southern England Branches.
26. **Confined Cups \*\*\*\*** – For dancers up to and including U9 who have never won a championship under 1 adjudicator, and dancers Under 10 upwards who have never won an Open championship under 1 or 3 adjudicators.

## NO SMOKING

**Anywhere within the school grounds, you must go outside of the school grounds, this includes electronic cigarettes and vapourisers. This is the ruling of the venue**
